

Draw and Helper's Roster: No Helper – No Rider Policy please provide helpers name and phone number via this e-mail <u>ritterfamily@ymail.com</u>, or confirm on the day when purchasing your tickets.

Every rider must have a helper and all jobs must be done or a substitute person nominated. <u>Please</u> remember these days cannot run without people to work as gate stewards, pencillers, rail stewards, sheet runners, scorers, etc.

Competitor's Responsibility:

Competitors are responsible for checking with the DPI regarding the requirement for spraying of horses.

Canteen facilities will be available all weekend.

A first aid officer will be available on the day. A vet will be on call but the owner/rider of the horse will be obliged to pay for the service

- Horse and Rider combinations may start in more than one Championship per day.
- Manure and Hay must be picked up and placed in designated Manure areas.
- All rubbish must be placed in bins.

Nominations:

Nominations can be made through <u>www.nominate.com.au</u> prior to or made at the nominations desk on the day of competition.

EQ Interschool State Championship qualifying rounds – in order for interschool qualifiers to be recognised by EQ, nominations must be made through www.nominate.com.au. Please note as per IQ rules, riders must have their IQ number attached to both sides of their saddle cloth.

Stables/Yards/Camping:

Stables/yards/camping are availabe and must be booked by sending a text message or calling Kaylene Ritter on 0407 742 508 or alternatively e-mail ritterfamily@ymail.com

Undercover stables are \$15 p/day, yards are \$7 p/day. Powered camping is \$15 per float/truck/tent per day. Payments must be made on first day of competition. All areas must be left clean or a cleaning fee will be charged. Stabling/yards must be cancelled a minimum of 7 days prior to the start of the show or full fee will be charged.
