Conditions of Entry

- · Horses may enter in only one section of a combined class/height
- · Horses may enter a maximum of two starts per day.
- Draws will be posted on Equipe by 6pm the day preceding competition.
- Ring 1 will run by draw order, Ring 2 by whiteboard.
- Refunds: Before close of entries, refunds will be made less \$20 admin fee per horse/rider. After close of entries, refunds will only be made if request is accompanied by a vet or doctor's certificate. Certificate must be submitted by email within 48 hours of event completion. (less \$20 admin fee per horse/rider) Email certificates to: gldshowjumpingclub@gmail.com
- Entry Changes: any changes to entries can be made up until 5pm the day prior to competition, changes are subject to \$10 admin fee.
- First Aid: any rider that fall from their horse must report to First Aid.
- This event is run under Equestrian Australia rules.

Membership – you <u>must</u> be a member to ride!! Validity of membership will be checked by QSJC and EQ

 Official Classes are open to Equestrian Australia members only. Proof of membership must be provided upon entry. All riders and owners must be financial members of EA to compete in official classes and all horses competing in official classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee. All registrations/memberships will be checked by

Equestrian Queensland. All horses and riders competing above 100cm MUST hold a full life registration and competitor licence with Equestrian Queensland.

 Unofficial Classes (under 105cm) are open to Equestrian Australia members and/or current financial members of Queensland Showjumping Club.

Guidelines for the Series:

- Horses must be EA Life Registered
- Horses must be in their first or second year of EA Full Life Horse Registration (based on calendar year):
 i.e. 2021 or 2022. * For the 2022 Series ONLY, horses that were EA Full Life Registered in 2020 will also be eligible.
- Horses must be owner ridden or leased
- Qualifier Rounds will be set at 1.05 maximum height in the first round, 1st fence to be no higher than 95cm (Second Round 1.10m max)
- Classes are run under Article 238.2.2
- All placegetters and double clear rounds will be eligible to compete in the finals at the end of the year
- A Greg Grant Saddlery Series Rug will be presented to the winner of each class. Prize money to 6th place
- . Horses must have 16 points and under to be eligible to compete.
